A testament to the company's reputation and diversity lies in the fact that when it came time to deliver the Royal Australian Navy's latest 57 metre Armidale class patrol vessels (ACPV) we were contacted by the vessel's through life operator and asked to supply the crew.

The shipyard also tapped into IMS's pool of experience when the vessels underwent commissioning sea trials by contacting us to supply the captain, chief engineer and mate. IMS has been involved in all but the first ACPV trials and our knowledge of their vessels along with a firm understanding of the shipyard, class and government requirements enables us to assist them to gain maximum results throughout the trials period.

In 2005, the Yemen Navy took delivery of ten 37 metre patrol vessels and as well as supplying crew for the commissioning trials, IMS formed part of a team put together to assist with the unloading of these vessels in the port of Hodeida. Once alongside at the Naval base dock facility we provided ongoing support in the form of familiarisation and recommissioning of the vessels systems.

2000 and 2001 saw the building and supply of eight (4 x 56 metre and 4 x 36 metre) Search and Rescue vessels to the Philippines Coast Guard. IMS was commissioned by the ship builder to carry out the sea trials here in Australia and then the delivery of the vessels from Fremantle to Manila. We were then contracted to perform a detailed training period in Manila to assure that the new crews would gain a complete understanding in the operation and maintenance of their newly acquired fleet.

As well as the above, we have successfully assisted in the commissioning of 12 x 16 metre NSW police patrol boats and their delivery from Fremantle to Sydney. Plus we supplied crew for the commissioning, range trials and crew training of the 10 x 37 metre Australian Customs patrol vessels. We are very proud that IMS is well thought of and trusted to carry out such high profile commissions.
